

**WINSOR TOWNSHIP  
BOARD MEETING  
APRIL 4, 2023**

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board was called to order by Matt Reibling, Supervisor, at 5:00 pm in the township boardroom.

Present: David Armbruster, Nancy Heck, David McCormick, Matt Reibling and John Walsh. Also present: Nick Pavlichek, Fire Chief.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

The minutes of the last regular meeting, held March 7, 2023, had been distributed to each board member. There being no additions or corrections, a motion was made by David McCormick, supported by Nancy Heck, to approve the minutes. The motion carried.

After review by board members, a motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to authorize payment of the April 2023 bills of \$ 11,937.44.

After a lengthy discussion, a motion was made by John Walsh, supported by Nancy Heck, that elected officials will receive no compensation other than their annual salary. The motion carried unanimously.

John Walsh presented journal entries, check register and financial statements for the General, road, Cemetery and ARPA Funds. A motion was made by David Armbruster, supported by David McCormick, to approve the financial information. The motion carried.

Nick Pavlichek, Fire Chief, reported on department activities. The Department has received a quote from Jack McCain Plumbing & Heating, Inc. to replace two[2] 50' Tube Heaters for the Fire Hall, at a cost of \$12,860.00. A motion was made by Nancy Heck, supported by David McCormick, to approve the purchase and installation of the 50' Tube Heaters from Jack McCain Plumbing & Heating using ARPA Funds. The motion carried.

David Armbruster reported that the combining of the two fire hall parcels will require a survey of the total property. A motion was made by Nancy Heck, supported by David McCormick, to authorize Mr. Armbruster to accept the lowest bid and proceed with the survey. The motion carried.


A motion was made by John Walsh, supported by David McCormick, to approve and post the April 2023 through April 2024 meeting schedule with the change of the July, 2023 meeting from the first Tuesday to the second Tuesday, July11, 2023. The motion carried.

Matt Reibling reviewed the proposed Wind Mill Settlement with a recommendation from our attorney. A moderate discussion ensued.

Mr. Reibling reported that the Village of Pigeon has requested the township's assistance in repaving the parking lot. Mr. Reibling will contact the Village President and request a copy of the township's original lease agreement with the village, to assist in determining the township's potential obligation, if any.

Mr. Reibling noted that the County Road Commission's Annual Meeting will be held on April 13, 2023 this year and any board member interested in attending should contact him.

At 6:40 pm, a motion to adjourn was made by John Walsh, supported by David Armbruster. The motion carried.
