

**WINSOR TOWNSHIP  
BOARD MEETING  
JUNE 7, 2022**

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board was called to order by Matt Reibling, Supervisor, at 5:05pm, in the township board room.

Present: David Armbruster, David McCormick. Matt Reibling and John Walsh. Also present: Nick Pavlechek, Fire Chief and Todd Talaski, Huron County Commissioner.

Absent: Nancy Heck.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Todd Talaski reported on county activities including the county building renovations.

The minutes of the last regular meeting, held May 3, 2022, had been distributed to each board member. There being no additions or corrections, a motion was made by David Armbruster, supported by David McCormick, to approve the minutes. The motion carried.

After review, a motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to authorize payment of the June 2022 bills of \$ 572,289.09. The motion carried.


John Walsh presented check registers, journal entries and General Fund financial statements as of May 31, 2022. A motion was made by David Armbruster, supported by David McCormick, to approve the financial information. The motion carried.

Nick Pavlechek, Fire Chief, reported on department activities including a “lot” of mutual aid calls.  
He also discussed mold in the fire building and several solutions.


John Walsh presented proposed expenditures to purchase election equipment, from a federal grant through the State of Michigan and using some ARPA Funds. The discussion was tabled until the next regular meeting.

John Walsh reported that he had received a request from the COOPERATIVE ELEVATOR Co. requesting approval of expanding the existing IFT District and an IFT Tax Exemption for a new building and equipment. A motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to hold a Public Hearing, at the next regular meeting scheduled for July 5, 2022. The motion carried with Matt Reibling abstaining.

There being no further business, a motion was made by David Armbruster, supported by David McCormick, to adjourn at 6:00pm. The motion carried.
