

Winsor Township Board Meeting May 2, 2023

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board was called to order by Matt Reibling, Supervisor, at 5:00 pm in the township boardroom.

Present: David Armbruster, Nancy Heck, David McCormick, Matt Reibling and John Walsh. Also present: Todd Talaski, Huron County Commissioner.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Public Comment: Todd Talaski reported that the county has located a replacement for the old MSU Extension building. After renovation, the old Print Shop building, which has recently closed due to retirement, will become the new MSU Extension building.

The minutes of the last regular meeting, held April 4, 2023, had been distributed to each board member. There being no additions or corrections, a motion was made by David Armbruster, supported by David McCormick, to approve the minutes. The motion carried.

After review and initialing by board members, a motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to approve the May 2023 bills of \$20,331.57. The motion carried.

John Walsh presented journal entries, check register and financial statements for the General, Road, Cemetery and ARPA Funds.

A motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to approve the financial information. The motion carried.

John Walsh reported that after becoming concerned about recent bank failures, he approached Thumb Bank & Trust Co. about how to have all township funds FDIC insured, and was informed that there is a program called CDRS [Certificate of Deposit Registration Service], that deposits funds in excess of \$250,000 in other banks that are FDIC insured, thereby covering all township funds.

A motion was made by John Walsh, supported by Nancy Heck, to authorize participation in that program. The motion carried with David McCormick abstaining.

A motion was made by John Walsh, supported by Nancy Heck, to recognize Thumb Bank & Trust Co. as the designated depository for township funds. The motion carried with David McCormick abstaining.


David Armbruster reported that he has been in contact with Joseph White from Wolverine Engineering & Surveying and received a very reasonable estimate for a new survey of the Fire Hall property. He was authorized to proceed with the project.

After discussion, a motion was made by David McCormick, supported by John Walsh, to adopt resolution 2023-05-01, in the form attached to these minutes, approving the Windmill Settlement. The motion carried and a copy of the resolution has been faxed to our attorney.


Matt Reibling reported on road projects for the current year.

Paving of the municipal parking lot was discussed and the township will wait until bids are received before determining our contribution to the project.

A motion to adjourn at 5:50 pm was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster. The motion carried.
