grass clippings that need to be  
taken care of before the weekly  
Wednesday Brush Pick-up by  
Emterra, please take them to the  
DPW Garage at 70 N. Main St..

## Leaf Pickup

We are asking that you place  
your leaves on the grass  
between the curb and the  
sidewalk. Placing the leaves on  
the grass, instead of the street,  
enables us to pick up the leaves  
during wet conditions and  
protects our storm sewers in the  
process. We will start picking  
up leaves on Mon., Oct. 7<sup>th</sup> and  
continue to be scheduled to pick  
up leaves on Mon. & Thurs.  
until Mon.. Nov. 25<sup>th</sup> Please  
have your leaves out by 7:00  
am on the day of pickup. **Do  
not place anything but leaves  
in the piles.** Also for  
everyone's safety please  
remember **if you can't see the  
operator of the Leaf Machine,  
he cannot see you.** Thank you  
for your cooperation
