It has been a very busy fall in
the Village. Work has been
completed at the Veterans Park
next to the Pigeon Event
Center, on the brick walkway
by the Veterans Monument.
Thanks to the GFWC Pigeon
Area Woman's Club, for
donating the bricks for the
walkway and two new benches,
which will be placed along the
walkway.

Paving work on the
Municipal Parking Lot by the
Village Hall has also been
completed. Pulverized millings
from the parking lot were used
to expand the parking lot at the
Pigeon Event Center. Great fall
weather has helped to complete
these projects along with
additional sidewalk work will
be done yet this fall.

Also work has been
completed on the Pigeon Lions
Pavilion at the Pigeon
Recreation Park. The pavilion

Leaf Pickup

We are asking that you place
your leaves on the grass
between the curb and the
sidewalk. Placing the leaves on
the grass, instead of the street,
enables us to pick up the leaves
during wet conditions and
protects our storm sewers in the
process. We will start picking
up leaves on **Mon., Oct. 9th** and
continue to be scheduled to pick
up leaves on Mon. & Thurs.
until **Mon. Nov. 27th** pending
the weather. Please have your
leaves out by 7:00 am on the
day of pickup. **Do not place
anything but leaves in the
piles.** Also for everyone's
safety please remember **if you
can't see the operator of the
Leaf Machine, he cannot see
you.** Thank you for your
cooperation

Emterra Yard Waste Collection

Please be sure to mark your container an "X" and face that "X" towards the street.

If you have branches, leaves or grass clippings that need to be taken care of please take them to the DPW Garage at 70 N. Main St. Please do not place tree branches, leaves and other yard debris out in the street. It creates a hazard for other residents. Please note that Emterra Yard Waste Collection ends November 29, 2023 and resumes again April 3, 2024.

Charges for Mowing

Services of mowing in the village will be charged to the property owner at current DPW hourly rates, with a minimum charge of \$150.00. If charges for mowing are not paid, the amount will be applies to the summer taxes

Site Permits

Site Permits need to be obtained any time you add a deck, fence, shed, addition ect... to your property, cost is \$40.00. If a permit is not obtained, a penalty of \$40.00 per permit will be assessed. If you have questions or unsure if you need a permit please contact the village hall.
