

WINSOR TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING
APRIL 6,2021

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board, was called to order at 5:00pm, by Matthew Reibling, Supervisor, in the Township Boardroom.

Present: David Armbruster, Nancy Heck, David McCormick, Matthew Reibling and John Walsh. Also present: Michael LePage & Steven Corrion, from the Village of Pigeon, Todd Talaski, County Commissioner and Nick Pavlechek, Fire Chief.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

The Winsor Township Police Protection Proposal From the Village was discussed and determined to be too expensive at this time. The Village representatives will come back with an hourly rate proposal.

Todd Talaski, Huron County Commissioner, discussed county issues including: windmill depreciation and court cases and that the County is scheduled to receive a \$6,000,000 Federal Covid Grant.

The minutes of the last meeting, held March 1, 2021 had been distributed to each board member, there being no additions or corrections, the minutes were ordered approved.

A motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to approve the bills paid March 2021 and to authorize payment of the April 2021 bills of \$25,375.56 to date. The motion carried with all voting yes.

A motion was made by David Armbruster, supported by David McCormick, to approve the journal entries and financial statements of the General, Cemetery and Road Funds as of March 31, 2021. The motion carried with all voting yes.

Nick Pavlechek, Fire Chief reported that the recent fish-fry served over 1100 people. Fire Fighter Level 2 will be starting soon, with two possible candidates from Winsor.

Matt Reibling reported that he had spoken with the Supervisors of Chandler and McKinley Townships and neither were happy with our proposed fire contracts. A motion was made by Nancy Heck, supported by David Armbruster, to void the contracts approved at the November 2020 board meeting and revert back to billing by section and to hire the firm of Accu-Med Billing to do individual fire billings and collections. The motion carried with all voting yes.


A motion was made by David McCormick, supported by John Walsh, to approve the Franchise Ordinance for Thumb Electric Cooperative { TEC } Ordinance # 2021-01. The motion carried with all voting yes.

Nancy Heck discussed a property issue in Linkville that she has been trying to work out for several years. A motion was made by John Walsh, supported by David McCormick, to have our attorney John Ferris, prepare a quit claim deed for this parcel and to review and fix the other easement if needed. The motion carried with all voting yes.

Matt Reibling reviewed proposed Road Fund projects for 2021. After which, a motion was made by David Armbruster, supported by Nancy Heck, to approve the projects totaling, approximately \$886,114. The motion carried with all voting yes.

A Winsor Township web site was discussed with no resolution.

There being no further business, a motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to adjourn The motion carried with all voting yes.
