May 4, 2021

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board, was called to order at 5:00 pm by Matthew Reibling, Supervisor, in the Township Boardroom.

Present: David Armbruster, Nancy Heck, David McCormick, Matthew Reibling and John Walsh. Also present: Todd Talaski, County Commissioner, Andrew Johnson of Apple Blossom Wind Farms and Tom Buschlen.

Tom Buschlen addressed the board regarding an abandoned house next to his property with the electric pole and wires about to collapse. A motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to have the Supervisor write a letter to Huron County requesting that Detroit Edison remove the pole and wiring. The motion carried. All voting yes.

Todd Talaski gave an update on County activities.

Andrew Johnson reported on Apple Blossom's current project's including trying to raise all "D" ratings.

The minutes of the last meeting, held April 6, 2021 had been distributed to each board member, after corrections, the minutes were ordered approved.
