

Winsor Township
Board Meeting
November 7, 2023

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board was called to order by Matt Reibling, Supervisor, at 5:00 pm in the township boardroom.

Nick Pavlichek, Fire Chief, reported on current activities. Noting that the department has found a candidate, to add to the department roll. Dan Armbruster. A motion was made by Nancy Heck, supported by David Armbruster, to add Dan Armbruster to the department. The motion carried.

Old Business: The Fire charge ordinance changes tabled at the prior meeting was presented with corrections discussed at prior meeting. A motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to accept the fire charge ordinance changes. The motion carried.

The board had a discussion on Clerk and Deputy Clerk duties and compensation. A motion was made by David Armbruster, supported by Nancy Heck, to table discussion until the next meeting. The motion carried.
