

WINSOR TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING
SEPTEMBER 7, 2021

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board was called to order by Matt Reibling, Supervisor, at 5.00pm in the Township Boardroom.

Present: David Armbruster, Nancy Heck, David McCormick Matt Reibling and John Walsh. Also present: Todd Talaski, Huron County Commissioner.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Todd Talaski gave up-dates on Huron County activities including Windmill tax appeals.

The minutes of the last regular meeting, held on August 3, 2021, had been distributed to each board member. There being no additions or corrections, a motion was made by David Armbruster, supported by David McCormick, to approve the minutes. The motion carried.

A motion was made by John Walsh, supported by Nancy Heck, to approve the payment the August 2021 bills of \$ 7,269.30, and to authorize the payment of the September 2021 bills of \$19,010.96. The motion carried.

John Walsh presented Journal Entries and General Fund Financial Statements as of August 31, 2021. A motion was made by David McCormick, supported by Nancy Heck, to approve the journal entries and financial statements. The motion carried.



Roll Call Vote : Armbruster yes, Heck yes, McCormick yes, Reibling yes, Walsh yes. The motion carried.

John Walsh presented an up-date on the Karle Family grave sites with before and after photos and noted that the overgrown flowers will be removed in the late Fall. Also tree stumps will be ground out and several trees trimmed by the end of Fall.

After discussion, bids will be sought for snow removal and salting for the fire hall and cemetery as soon as specs. are assembled.
