Another Summerfest Wing
Fling has come and gone. Thanks
to all the residents, businesses,
civic organizations, Winsor
Township Fire Department and
volunteers for working
and attending our many events and
making our festival a tremendous
success.

We have several projects going
on in the Village for the remainder
of the summer such as sidewalk
replacement, street paving, storm
sewer repairs and tree and stump
removal.

The Village has been approved
for the SAW Grant from the State
of Michigan to do cleaning and
televising of our Sanitary Sewer
System. This will help pin point
any problems so we can prioritize
repair projects in the future.

Work continues at Veterans
Park next to the VFW Hall to
install the transmission lines by
Sempra Renewables. Upon
completion of the project, and
when in production, the Village
will receive as part of a long term
contract, approximately \$15,000 to
\$18,000 per year contribution for
our community wide park system.
We received many compliments
during our festival as to the
cleanliness of our town. Thanks to
all residents who help to make our
little community one of the best
