Run Water Continue

Please continue running one cold
water tap at no bigger than a pencil
lead size stream. The village will
contact you via the Phone Tree for
updates. Please remember that you
only need to run one cold water tap
at no bigger than a pencil lead size
stream.

Water/Sewer Run Credit

On January 6, 2018 residents were
notified by the Village Phone Tree
to run one cold water tap at no
bigger than a pencil lead size
stream. The reason is to help
protect the village water mains and
residential service lines from
freezing up. Running one cold
water tap at no bigger than a pencil
lead size stream has a consumption
of about 48 gallon per day. Since
the Village is still under a run
water advisory credits will be
applied to the April 1, 2018
Village Utility Billing. Please
remember that you only need to
run one cold water tap at no bigger
than a pencil lead size stream.
You will be notified via the
Village Phone Tree when it is safe
to stop running water. Thank you
for your cooperation.

Brush Pick-up

Brush pick-up will resume the last
Thursday in April, weather
permitting. If you have branches
you can take them to the DPW
garage at 70 N. Main St. Please do
not set them out in the street, it
creates a hazard for everyone.
