## Dear Residents,

Spring and Summer Village  
projects are well under way. The  
walking path project at the  
Recreation Park is nearing paving  
completion. Cement pads were  
poured adjacent to the path to be  
used for benches and signage. A  
large entrance sign will be erected  
at the start of the path just off of  
School Street and Country Bay  
Drive. Dedication of the path is  
being scheduled on June  
23rd during the Scheurer Hospital  
“Spark in the Park”. The wellness  
walking path has been established  
with donations from many  
community minded entities. The  
last phase of the project will be  
lighting the path with Solar  
Lighting, with funding yet to be  
raised. If you are interested in

Renovations have begun at the
