Yard Waste

Emterra's yard waste pickup will resume in April 1, 2022. If you have branches or grass clippings that need to be taken care of inbetween time, please take them to the DPW Garage at 70 N. Main St. Please do not place tree branches, leaves and other yard debris out in the street.

Charges for Mowing

Services of mowing in the village will be charged to the property owner at current DPW hourly rates, with a minimum charge of \$150.00. If charges for mowing are not paid then amount will be applies to the summer taxes

Zoning Permits

Zoning Permits need to be obtained any time you add a deck, fence, shed ect... to your property, cost is \$40.00. If a permit is not obtained, a penalty of \$40.00 per permit will be assessed. If you have questions or unsure if you need a permit please contact the village hall.

Utility Bill Payment
