construction projects are
finished. N. Frank Street is
finished for the year, with a
final blacktop coat scheduled
for the spring. Please keep in
mind that this \$600,000 project
has been paid in full with tax
money and a grant from the
state, resulting in no short or
long term debt for the residents
of Pigeon. Along with the N.
Frank St paving Dwight Gascho
Drive from Park Street to Bliss
Street was also resurfaced.

Our next planned
infrastructure improvement
project will take place in 2024
with a joint project of Berne St.
which will be in cooperation
with Winsor Township, Village
of Pigeon, and the Cooperative
Elevator Company.

In the Recreation Park the
Pigeon Lion's Pavilion project
has been put on hold until
spring.

Zoning Permits

Zoning Permits need to be obtained any time you add a deck, fence, shed, addition ect... to your property, cost is \$40.00. If a permit is not obtained, a penalty of \$40.00 per permit will be assessed. If you have questions or unsure if you need a permit please contact the village hall.
