#### **Council Election**

# **Emterra Request**

Emterra is asking that for the safety of the sanitation workers, all trash must be placed in tied bags starting immediately. Tied bags can still be placed in barrels, but it has to be in tied bags. All trash not in bags will not be picked up. Doing this small part, will help keep everyone safe. Emterra will continue trash pickup every Wednesday.

# **Charges for Mowing**

Services of mowing in the village will be charged to the property owner at current DPW hourly rates, with a minimum charge of \$150.00. If charges for mowing are not paid then amount will be applies to the summer taxes.

#### **Zoning Permits**

Zoning Permits need to be obtained any time you add a deck, fence, shed ect... to your property. They are issued by the Zoning Administrator at a \$40.00 per inspection fee.
