The Water Fund ended the year with an Unassigned Fund Balance of (\$375,402.00) an increase because of the project. The Trunkline Fund end the year with an Unassigned Fund Balance of (3,298.00) which was a decrease from \$(7,129.00). Overall the village had a very good year.
