He noted that the villages General Fund, Unassigned Fund Balance increased by \$26,001.00 to \$631,800.00 which is 74.4% of the General Fund expenditures. The Sewer Fund, ended the year with a Unassigned Fund Balance of \$359,656.00 a decrease of \$25,693.00. The Water Fund ended the year with a Unassigned Fund Balance of (\$186,264.00) a decrease of \$42,435.00 The only fund to end the year in the red was the Trunkline Fund at (6,422.00) with an Unassigned Fund Balance of \$(18,365.00). Overall the village had a very good year.
