As we wind up the fall cleanup season, we will be picking up leaves weather permitting.

Street paving for this year is complete, and we will be assessing next year's work as we budget for 2018. Council also plans on budgeting for more sidewalk repair in 2018.

Thanks to Sempra Wind Energy, Barton/Malow, and Motor City Electric our walking path will have lights on poles all the way around the path by December 15th.
